STARTING LINE: North-west of the northern entrance to Oban Bay, between an orange flag on an Official Boat and a black inflatable mark laid for the purpose.

NOTE: The Starting Line may be situated up to four miles from Oban Bay, and competitors should, therefore, ensure that they leave harbour in sufficient time.

MARKS OF THE COURSE

- (1) Lismore Island shall be left to port.
- (2) Creag Island (56°28.6'N, 5°30.9 'W) shall be left to port.
- (3) An orange inflatable mark laid about three and a half cables south-east of Eilean Glas (56°34.4'N, 5°25.3'W) shall be left to port.
- (4) An orange inflatable mark laid about two and a half cables north-east of Eilean Glas (56°34.4'N, 5°25.3'W) shall be left to port.
- (5) Sgeir nan Tom (56°34.4'N, 5°26.4'W) shall be left to port.
- (6) Two orange inflatable marks forming a gate laid one cable apart at right angles to the course, with the easternmost mark about two cables west of Liath Sgeir (56°28.4'N, 5°36.3'W).
- (7) Lismore Lighthouse (56°27.3'N, 5°36.4'W) shall be left to port.
- (8) An orange inflatable mark laid north of Maiden Island shall be left to starboard.

CAUTION: Particular attention should be paid to the isolated danger of Liath Sgeir (56°28.4'N, 5°36.3'W) north-west of Lismore Lighthouse.

FINISHING LINE: Off Maiden Island, between a blue flag on an Official Boat and a black inflatable mark laid for the purpose.

DISTANCE: About 23 miles, or less, depending on position of Starting/Finishing Line.

TIME LIMIT for all classes will be 1600.
